
Our Lady Queen of Palestine, we pray to you for a deliverance to LOVE from the hated and sorrow of these people.





**PRAYER FOR OUR SEMINARIANS...**Saint Junipero Serra is considered the patron saint of vocations. He was a Spanish Franciscan priest who wanted to be a missionary. Father Serra was an advocate for the poor and other vulnerable people. He founded 9 missions in what is now present-day California. He was canonized on September 23, 2015, by Pope Francis, the first canonization to take place on American soil. Our Seminarians in the Holy Land had to discern what they want to do with their lives. The Seminarians want to spread the Gospel through our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. Let us all pray for their continued journey with Jesus, and the Queen of Palestine's protection over them and the people of Israel.

**JUSTICE & PEACE**...Three major religions serve as custodians of the Holy Sepulchre—Roman Catholics, Greek Orthodox and The Armenian Church. It's impossible to go on a pilgrimage and not be taken in by the beauty of Greek Orthodox influence and artwork. On October 22nd memorial services were held at Christian Churches throughout the Holy Land, including The Holy Sepulchre for eighteen people killed at St. Porphyrius, seventeen were Christian.

The Greek Orthodox church in Gaza City serves as a shelter whenever hostilities erupt between Palestinians and Israelis. On October 19th four hundred people were inside when Israel struck a nearby building and damaged the church. They suspected Hamas of using the building as a command center to launch rockets. The IDF states the church was not a target. "I don't think that is an excuse to hit these places near a church where people are hiding," said Rev. Fadi Diab, an Anglican minister in Ramallah.

St. Porphyrius dates to the twelfth century. Churchgoers plowed through heaps of concrete to save those trapped in the rubble. Screaming and wailing pierced the air. "My mother's inside, my son's inside, my sister's inside." A former Congressman from Michigan, Justin Amash, lost several relatives.

Christians still choose to remain at the Orthodox Church and Holy Family, a nearby Catholic Church. Israel has urged everyone to evacuate Gaza City. St. Porphyrius "seems to be the only place that can take us. We Christians have no one in the south," said Kamel Ayyad, a churchgoer. Many fear a journey to nowhere more than a ground assault.

ENGAGEMENT & ENHANCEMENT... Engaging our members in our Las Vegas projects...



**LVC MEN'S BOOK CLUB...** This month we've finished and discussed "The Screwtape Letters" by C.S. Lewis; a classic masterpiece of religious satire that entertains readers with its sly and ironic portrayal of human life and foibles from the vantage point of Screwtape, a highly placed assistant to "Our Father Below." In this probing and heartfelt book, the author examines some of the challenging questions at the core of Christian spirituality. Join us! Get "The Promise of Paradox", read it, and bring your views and thoughts to our next meeting on November 29th.



MOTHER RONCEVALLES, of Hogar Ninos Dios..." Thank you for your prayers, keep us in your Holy Mass"..."Thank you for your prayers...WE NEED THEM."

FR. LOUIS SALMAN, our First Seminarian now Priest and Vocation Director at Beit Jala Seminary..." they are telling us that people are still under the rubble. Prayer is our salvation" ..." there is no safe place in Gaza, Christians are being killed, as are many under the rubble."

FR. BERNARD POGGI, Rector Abouna of the Beit Jala Seminary..."the situation is definitely getting worse, not better...I do not know how much more people can handle, God help us"..."Joseph/Connie/LV, thank you for your prayers, we see that they are working. I hope that things will continue to move towards peace."

MAHER NAHAS, finest Pilgrim guide and wonderful Catholic Husband/Father..."HellIlloooo Joe, feels great to hear from you, thanks for all your prayers, it is a big support for us all"..."we love you all Joe, big smile to all, thank you for all the prayers."
