Simply put, the cards were boxed and mailed on Friday, October 6th and I was informed that our box should reach its destination in 10-days. I was surprised and very happy to hear this and I informed the committee members of the good news!

The conflict between Israel and Hamas began the next day and once the conflict began Betty Boyd volunteered to track the box daily.

10/8 thru 10/28: The box is in transit to the next facility at the LAX International Transit Center.

10/29 thru 11/18: The box has been processed through LAX International Distribution Center.

11/19: The box departed from LAX International Transit onto its destination.


11/28: The box has cleared customs in Israel and the processing is complete.



JUSTICE & PEACE... Ever go to daily Mass and you can't put your finger on it, but something's missing? Then you attend Sunday, you hear the beautiful organ, and things come to life just a little bit more. Elham Farah was the eighty-four-year-old former organist and music teacher at Holy Family Church in Gaza City. She also played the piano, touching parishioners' hearts with sweet harmony and grace. Seven-hundred-fifty people currently shelter inside Holy Family. Elham was one of them. Prior to the cease-fire, she wanted to know if her house and possessions survived the bombings. I imagine her friends imploring her not to go, telling her it's not worth the risk. She insisted she'd be all right.

A sniper shot Elham in the leg as she approached her home. She bled to death in front of it. It was too dangerous for anyone to save her life. Her body remained there for quite some time before they could retrieve it and give her a proper burial. The orphans and refugees inside Holy Family are afraid. No bombs or shots have landed, but everything around there is destroyed.

LVC MEN'S BOOK CLUB... Just finished *"The Power of Paradox - A celebration of contradictions in the Christian life"*. The book was a little challenging as it was a compilation of 6 essays, not directly connected, written by a Ph D from the University of Berkeley in California in 1980. Of note the book was republished in 2008 with an extensive introductory 'explanation' from a 'more seasoned scholar'. Dr Palmers' update allowed for a lively discussion within our group.

Our next book is *"The Power and the Glory"* is a 1940 novel by British author Graham Greene. The title is an allusion to the doxology recited at the end of the Lord's Prayer: "For thine is the kingdom, the power, and the glory, forever and ever, amen." It was initially published in the United States under the title "The Labyrinthine Ways".

Greene's novel tells the story of a renegade Catholic 'whisky priest' (a term coined by Greene) living in the Mexican state of Tabasco in the 1930s, a time when the Mexican government was attempting to suppress the Catholic Church. That suppression had resulted in the Cristero War (1926–1929), so named for its Catholic combatants' slogan "Viva Cristo Rey" ("Long live Christ the King").
