YES, prayers for the many (on both fronts) who need this CONVERSION of HEART. There is no other way. The EOHSJ is best suited to fulfill Christ's call to...








PILGRIMAGES SPONSORED BY THE LV COUNCIL....



JUSTICE & PEACE...Virtually everyone in Gaza is struggling to get enough food—2.3 million people. Nearly a third of the population is experiencing the highest level of catastrophic hunger.

In the north, outright famine is projected within two months, the World Bank said. They warned that if Israel broadens its offensive to the packed southern city of Rafah, as Prime Minister Netanyahu vowed, the fighting could drive over 1 million people into catastrophic hunger and potentially cause famine in the south.

"This is the largest number of people facing imminent famine in the world today, and it has only taken five months to occur," said Matthew Hollingworth, the acting World Food Program country director for the Palestinian territories.


"It is not a question of logistics. It is not because the United Nations has not provided enough support. Trucks are stopped. People are dying, while the land crossings are artificially closed."

Starvation has driven Palestinians to eat grass, weeds, and mix animal fodder and bird feed in flour to make bread. "We have stopped differentiating between donkey food and human food. We are eating anything," Mazen Terk, 30, told Middle East Eye.

European Union foreign policy chief Josep Borrell said, "Israel is using starvation as a weapon of war." Israel denies the tactic and says that claims of widespread hunger are false.

ENGAGEMENT... MINUTE SPOTLIGHT...MARCH 2024 ROSARY. It is my pleasure to introduce you to Sir George Rogers and Dame Tammy Rogers.

LVC MEN'S BOOK CLUB...We've finished reading. "The Scarlet Letter, by Nathaniel Hawthorne" written in 1850 some 200 years after the occurrences in the Puritanical New England wilderness, between a woman, a man, and child. The woman who sinned embraces her sin and survives, the man who covers his sin dies, and the child they had together inherits a fortune and lives ever after. Quite a story.

Of note (in the last few pages) as in almost an epilogue in the story Hawthorne writes ... "Women ... came to Hester (the woman referred to above) asked why they were ... wretched ... She assured them, too, of her firm belief that, at some brighter period, when the world should have grown ripe for it, in Heaven's own time, a new truth would be revealed, in order to establish the whole relation between man and woman on a surer ground of mutual happiness." From 1650 ...


Our next read "The Spear. by Louis de Wohl" ... a novel about the Centurion who hurled his spear into Christ's side. A novel set in the times preceding and after the Crucifixion. Where was the Centurion before, was he at the trial, the scourge, the agonizing walk to Calvary? What about after? We know expressed belief ... "This man was truly the son of God" ... What else?

This panoramic novel of the last days of Christ ranges from the palaces of imperial Rome to the strife-torn hills of Judea-where the conflict of love and betrayal, revenge, and redemption, reaches a mighty climax in the drama of the Crucifixion. For this is the full story of the world's most dramatic execution, as it affected one of its least-known participants-the man who hurled his spear into Christ on the Cross.







Today's (4/2/24) Gospel (John 20:11-18) gives us some of the most timely and important words of guidance for Dames and Knights.
