Fr. Edmund was born in Nigeria to a Catholic family – which, he says, "informed my direction...to become a priest." Following his minor seminary training, he found that he was attracted to the missionary priesthood, which would take him far from home

and family. But it was his spirit of adventure that confirmed his decision and he was ordained a priest of the missionaries of St. Paul – MSP - on June 28, 1997.

His journey to the United States was part of a quest for further education, which included earning his Ph.D. in Chicago. He recalled that "coming to Las Vegas was not even on my radar" but "I was ready to minister where needed." He is now pastor at St. Thomas More parish in Henderson where he established the Knights of Columbus and the Legion of Mary in order to strengthen the spiritual life of his parishioners.

He enjoys working with people and, he says, "it gladdens my heart to see the growth of the parish. It is quite fulfilling doing the work of God." This is very apparent to all who know Fr. Edmund! Come meet Fr. Edmund at our July Rosary and learn more about him!



LV COUNCIL BOOK CLUB UPDATE...GRATITUDE TO SIR JEFF FOR HIS DEDICATION...We have finished reading "The Spear", a novel by Louis de Wohl. A fascinating story of the Centurion who thrust a spear into Christ's side at Calvary. Beginning in Rome and then to Jerusalem. We read of his struggles, relationships and engagement with others. The author sets up a narrative between and among all the characters who we know well from the Passion story. They are all there, wondering who Jesus is and what he is about doing, as well as how to deal with him. We read of Caiphas' dealing with Herod and Pilot. Barabbas with 6,000 men planning to rid the country of Romans. Yet he is freed. It's a narrative, made up, a fiction. However, there should be little question that something like this did happen 2,000 years gone by...Good literature makes you think.

Our current book is "To Sanctify the World ... The Legacy of Vatican II" by George Weigel. Best to quote Timothy Cardinal Dolan, from the book jacket ... "Historians tell us the genuine interpretation of an Ecumenical Council's teaching usually at least takes sixty years to settle. This means we are now at the point of serenely and sanely understanding the authentic magisterium of Vatican Council II. And count on Weigel to provide an attractive and compelling synthesis of it." It's a challenging read, but one we all believe worthwhile.

JUSTICE & PEACE...WHY RAFAH?

Israel told fleeing Palestinians to escape to Rafah, Gaza's southernmost town. They shelter in densely packed tent camps, overflowing U.N. dwellings or crowded apartments. They depend on international aid for food. Their sanitation systems and medical facilities are crippled.

Now, Israel's determined to launch a ground offensive there, claiming Hamas has four battalions inside the city. But the plan has raised global alarm because of the potential harm to 1.4 million refugees.

"We will enter Rafah because we have no other choice. We will destroy the Hamas battalions there, we will complete all the objectives of the war, including the return of all our hostages," Netanyahu said.

The U.S. urged Israel not to carry out the operation without a credible plan to evacuate more than 1 million civilians taking refuge in Rafah. Egypt sits just across Gaza's southern border from Rafah, and has said an Israeli military seizure of the border — which is supposed to be demilitarized — or any move to push Palestinians into Egypt would threaten its four-decade-old peace agreement with the Jewish state.

The U.N. Secretary-General renewed his warning that a military offensive in Rafah would be "an unbearable escalation, killing thousands more civilians and forcing hundreds of thousands to flee."

The question of attacking Rafah carries heavy political implications for Netanyahu. His government has been threatened with collapse if he doesn't go through with it...

CLOSING WORDS FROM A MAN WE LOVE FROM THE HOLY LAND....

This month's closing is not from Joe/Connie but from one of our Living Stones we have known for over a decade. We asked our dear friend, Maher, to honor us with a few words on his amazing life...please pray for his family and all our living stones...

Dear Joe,

Hope you and Connie are doing well. I hope that my words are able to convey a short message about the situation in the Holy Land. Thank you and blessings for your care...... Maher.



My name is Maher Nahhas. I was born in a little village called Tarshiha in western upper Galilee located five miles from the Lebanese border and about an hour north of the Sea of Galilee. So, I am a Galilean!

I'm married to Rania, an English teacher, we met in high school! We have two grown sons, twins, who are 22 years old, and who are currently studying at a university in Germany.

Here in our village of Tarshiha and throughout the Holy Land, we are facing a very tough and challenging period of time. The situation, after seven months of non-stop fighting, is becoming more complicated and unpredictable each day.

Up here, in the North, where I live, we hear bombing daily from both sides. Thousands of people have been evacuated from the villages and towns near the border. It is not unusual that I would be walking my dog, Bello (a golden retriever), and we would hear sirens and have to run back home to get into a shelter. Still life goes one, and we are able to practice our daily routine, meaning people go to work, schools are open, but everyone is just always living on the edge.

All the pilgrimage groups that I was supposed to guide have been cancelled until the end of 2025, and this is the situation for all of those who work in this ministry of pilgrimage. Our friends in Jerusalem and Bethlehem and the rest of the West Bank are facing an even more difficult reality. Please keep them, and us, in your prayers, as you Knights and Dames of the Holy Sepulchre remain in ours.
