In 2012, Deacon Ryan was in his 4th year of diaconate formation, and was given a two-part assignment to both engage his parish in his formation process, and to create a project with a social justice theme that would be at service to others in need. At this time, Deacon Ryan and his wife Dame Wynsdey had also recently been invested into the EOHSJ. So they joined two of their loves: Diaconal ministry and EOHSJ, and right then the OLQP Mission was born.

What started as a one-time homework assignment done on the Feast day of Our Lady Queen of Palestine has evolved into a yearround Mission. Throughout the course of the year, Deacon Ryan and Dame Wynsdey travel to parishes, both all over California, but have now branched out to other States as well. The weekends consist of Deacon Ryan serving at all the parish Masses and preaching and speaking about the works of the OLQP Mission. Dame Wynsdey, often times assisted by other wonderful Dames of the Order, are at an information table with information tri-folds. Olive Wood items sent to us from Bethlehem. and handmade Rosaries, made and donated to the OLQP Mission by Dame Joanne and Sir Larry Lazar. We also have an annual fun Bingo night created by Deacon Joe and Dame Annie Flores, and of course, the now famous Golf Tournament created by Sir Jim and Dame Judy Salz, which both benefit the OLQP Mission.
