

Our Daily Itinerary

May 11, Mon: Departure May 12, Tue: Arrival-Lisbon

Upon landing at Lisbon Portela Airport, we will pick up our luggage and proceed to be greeted by our tour guide and/or driver. Transfer to our hotel in Lisbon for a restful evening, dinner & overnight at the hotel.

May 13, Wed: Lisbon-Full day

After breakfast, we begin a guided tour of Lisbon, starting at Santo Antonio da Sé, the site where St. Anthony of Padua, patron saint of Portugal, was born in 1195. We then visit the Sé de Lisboa, the city's oldest church, dating back to the 12th century, where we see the font in which the saint was baptized and celebrate Mass. The tour continues with a panoramic view of the iconic Belem Tower, also known as the Tower of St. Vincent, a 16th-century fortification, and an exterior visit to the Gothic Monastery of St. Jeronimo. The afternoon is free for personal exploration, and we gather in the evening for **dinner at a local restaurant.**

May 14, Thu: Santarem-Fatima

After breakfast at the hotel, we depart for Fatima, stopping first in Santarem to visit the revered site of the Eucharistic Miracle.

We then continue to Fatima, one of the most significant Marian apparition sites in the world. Our day begins with a visit to the Little Chapel of the Apparitions, where the Virgin Mary first appeared to the three shepherd children in 1917. We continue to the Basilica of Our Lady of the Rosary, which holds the tombs of St. Francisco, St. Jacinta, and Sister Lucia, and features altars dedicated to the fifteen mysteries of the Rosary. In the square, we pause at the Sacred Heart of Jesus monument, then visit the Museum: Fatima—Light and Peace, followed by the Holy Trinity Basilica. After free time for lunch, we walk the Stations of the Cross along the Via Sacra, a path marked by chapels commemorating Christ's Passion, ending at the Chapel of Calvary. We conclude our day at Valinhos, site of the August apparition and angelic visits, before enjoying dinner and an overnight stay in Fatima.

May 15, Fri: Fatima – Porto- Santiago De Compostela

This morning, we celebrate Mass in Fatima (subject to availability) then we depart for Porto. On arrival in Porto, enjoy a visit Continue with a short panoramic tour of the city's highlights. After some free time for lunch, we head north once again we cross into Spain and continue through the rolling hills

of Galicia, arriving in Santiago de Compostela. Dinner & overnight night in Santiago de Compostela.

May 16, Sat: Santiago De Compostela

After breakfast at the hotel we begin with a guided tour of the Cathedral of Santiago, the resting place of St. James the Apostle, whose relics have drawn pilgrims for over a thousand years. We take time to pray and reflect at the Apostle's tomb, admire the magnificent Portico of Glory. (We celebrate Mass at the cathedral subject to availability), joining fellow pilgrims from around the world in worship and thanksgiving. Following our spiritual visit, we enjoy a walking tour through the charming Old Town, a UNESCO World Heritage Site, with its winding medieval streets, Romanesque churches, and lively squares. After some free time for personal prayer, shopping, or a quiet lunch, we regroup for a peaceful drive back to our hotel for dinner & overnight.

May 17, Sun: Santiago De Compostela- Oviedo-Santander

After breakfast in Santiago de Compostela, depart for a scenic drive through the lush landscapes of northern Spain. Upon arrival, visit the Cathedral of San Salvador, home to the Chapel of the Holy Chamber which houses some of Spain's most revered relics, including the Sudarium of Oviedo, believed by many to have covered the face of Christ. Spend time in prayer and exploration of this deeply historic site before continuing eastward along the northern coast to the seaside city of Santander. On arrival, enjoy a peaceful visit to Santander Cathedral, a tranquil space of reflection overlooking the Bay of Biscay. The rest of the evening is free to relax, walk along the elegant waterfront promenade. Dinner & overnight in Santander.

May 18, Mon: Santander-San Sebastian-Lourdes

After breakfast, depart Santander and travel east to the coastal gem of San Sebastián, known for its scenic bay, elegant architecture, and spiritual charm. While in San Sebastián, visit the striking Buen Pastor Cathedral, the largest religious building in the city, and also stop at the Basilica of Saint Mary of the Chorus, a beautiful Baroque church located in the heart of the Old Town. After time for prayer and a peaceful stroll along La Concha promenade, continue the journey across the Pyrenees into France, arriving in Lourdes by evening. Settle into our hotel, enjoy dinner, and if time permits, join pilgrims from around the world for the Rosary and Candlelight Procession at the Sanctuary.

May 19, Tue & May 20, Wed: Lourdes

In the next two days will explore a small town that is nestled within the Pyrenees Mountains. During our time in Lourdes, we will pray and meditate in yet another site of Our Lady's apparitions. Our Lady first appeared to Bernadette in 1858, and announced herself as "The Immaculate Conception", near the Grotto of Massabielle. During the first two apparitions, little Bernadette prayed the Rosary with Our Lady and left without any exchange of words. During the following apparitions, Our Lady emphasized God's love for us, penance and the necessity of performing acts of penance for sinners. Throughout our time in Lourdes, we will have the opportunity to attend Mass at the

Grotto, where Our Lady appeared to Bernadette; watch a video presentation that explains, in detail, the story of Lourdes; drink water from the miraculous spring that has healed many; and submerge yourself in the healing baths. Additionally, we will have the opportunity to experience Christ's unconditional love, as we meditate upon the "life size" Stations of the Cross that overlook the Grotto of Massabielle. Dinner & overnight at the Hotel.

May 21, Thu: Lourdes - Andorra

This morning after breakfast we will travel along the French Pyrenean valleys, crossing the mountain range by way of Andorra. We will visit Andorra la Vella, the capital, where we'll enjoy a short walking tour of the old town. We'll visit St Esteve Church, a historic Romanesque church dedicated to Saint Stephen, located in the heart of the city. We will take some free time to explore the peacful streets and visit local shops. Dinner & overnight in Andora.

May 22, Fri: Andorra- Barcelona (Panoramic tour & Gothic Quarter)

Today we travel to the vibrant city of Barcelona, where we begin with a panoramic tour of the city. We'll drive through the elegant Eixample district, famous for its grand avenues and remarkable Modernist architecture. Along Passeig de Gràcia, we admire iconic buildings such as Casa Lleó Morera, Casa Amatller, Casa Batlló, and La Pedrera (Casa Milà)—all stunning works of artistic innovation. We then make our way up to Montjuïc Hill, known for its sweeping views of the city and coast, and its cultural and Olympic landmarks. Later in the afternoon, we head into the heart of Barcelona's historic Gothic Quarter, where we explore on foot. We'll visit the magnificent Santa Maria del Mar, stroll through the charming medieval streets, visit the Cathedral of Barcelona, and experience the energy of Las Ramblas, the city's iconic pedestrian boulevard. Dinner and overnight in Barcelona.

May 23, Sat: Barcelona (Sagrada Familia- Park Guell)

This morning, after breakfast, we dedicate our time to the extraordinary spiritual and artistic legacy of Antoni Gaudí. We begin with a visit to his most famous masterpiece: **the Basilica of the Sagrada Família.** With its towering spires and deep Christian symbolism carved into every detail, this basilica is one of the most inspiring architectural expressions of faith in the modern world. We then visit **Park Güell**, a vibrant and whimsical park designed by Gaudí, filled with colorful mosaics, natural forms, and breathtaking views of the city. The remainder of the afternoon and evening is free for personal time. You may choose to revisit favorite spots, explore local shops and cafés, enjoy quiet time in a chapel, or simply relax and take in the spirit of Barcelona at your own pace. * Farewell dinner at a local restaurant.

May 24, Sun: Return home from Barcelona.
